MM 635-S, WHO HAS FURNISHED RELIABLE INFO IN THE PAST, AND IS A MEMBER OF THE THIRTY OF NOVEMBER (MRTN) FURNISHED FOLLOWING INFO ON JULY 19 LAST MRTN, COMANDOS L, AND R E C E, ANTI CASTRO GROUPS PLANNED A MEETING FOR JULY 22 LAST. RAMON FONT SAUMELL, MILITARY LEADER OF COMANDOS L SAID HE WOULD RETURN TO SAN JUAN P.R. ON JULY 20 LAST AND THE MEETING WOULD HAVE TO BE POSTPONED. FONT INDICATED HE MIGHT CONSIDER A MISSION AGAINST CUBA SCHEDULED FOR ABOUT JULY 26 NEXT BUT GAVE NO DETAILS. *(S)(u)*

ON JULY 23 LAST CIA MIAMI ADVISED THE FOLLOWING: R E C E WAS PLANNING A MISSION AGAINST CUBA SCHEDULED FOR JULY 23 OR JULY 24 LAST. FOUR MEN, IDENTITIES UNKNOWN, WOULD PICK UP ARMS IN THE LOWER FLA., KEYS, AND A TWENTYTHREE FOOT BOAT WOULD

ON JULY 23 LAST U.S. CUSTOM MIAMI ADVISED THEY ARE INVESTIGATING THIS MATTER AND MAINTAINING PHYSICAL SURVEILLANCES ON BOATS KNOWN TO BE USED BY THIRTY OF NOVEMBER AND COMANDOS L, AND WILL MAINTAIN PHYSICAL SURVEILLANCES UNTIL AFTER JULY 26 NEXT.

MIAMI IS RECONTACTING MM 635-S AND OTHER SOURCES AND WILL KEEP CUSTOMS AND THE BUREAU ADVISED. (u)
