Source advised that he has gone no further then to talk this matter over with the FBI and has told his contact people in Comandos L that he needs time to think about this matter. He will now proceed further with this plan, placing emphasis on the fact that his three conditions must be met.

Source also pointed out a problem concerning his immigration status if he decides to participate in this "raid". We is in the United States as a refugee and presently his immigration papers are on file at the United States embassy in Santo Domingo. He anticipates that he will receive an invitation from the embassy in the near future to travel to Santo Domingo in order to obtain his resident alien status, thereby granting him facility to depart from the United States and to reenter at will.
