A review of the Chicago files and investigation by the Chicago Division has failed to reflect any information that individuals identified as members or former members of Minutemen are purchasing arms and ammunition for use in carrying out the stated objectives of the organization, thereby posing a threat to the life of the President and other public officials.

There is no indication from information obtained by the Chicago Division that the activities of Minutemen and/or its members are in violation of any Federal statutes over which the Bureau has investigative jurisdiction.

Consideration has been given to every source concealed and "T" symbols were utilized only in those instances where the identity of the sources must be concealed.

On July 9, 1964, BERNARDO B. SPEISER was interviewed and furnished names and addresses of individuals who were mailed Minutemen literature in envelopes with a return address of Animal Drug Products Company, Inc., 4122 West Grand Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. The names and addresses contained on these envelopes were previously furnished to the Bureau and other interested Offices by Chicago airtel to the Bureau, dated July 22, 1964, and are not set forth in this report.
