On October 21, 1960, PSI [redacted]
[redacted] Traffic Supervisor, Cubana Airlines, Miami International Airport, with whom insufficient contact has been had to judge his reliability but who is in a position to furnish the information requested, advised that he had no information concerning the FPCC or any flight to Cuba sponsored by the FPCC.

On October 21, 1960, OLIVIO MORENO, Traffic Department, Pan American World Airways, Miami International Airport (protect identity by request), advised that he had no information concerning any trip to Cuba from Miami sponsored by the FPCC via Pan American World Airways.

On November 17, 1960, PSI [redacted] (u) (X)
[redacted] with whom insufficient contact has been had to judge reliability, advised that the FPCC has been in existence for a considerable period of time, that its headquarters are in New York City, and that it publishes a pamphlet called "Fair Play". This source advised that the FPCC is definitely a pro-CASTRO organization, but stated that there is no indication that the FPCC has any connections with the Communist Party or the Socialist Workers Party in the Miami area.

Miami will endeavor to develop further pertinent information concerning the activities of FPCC in the Miami area, and will immediately advise the Bureau and interested offices of any further developments.
