On 10/23/64, STANLEY SCHACTER, Customs Agent, Miami, advised SA JOSEPH P. MC CANN that Customs was conducting surveillances in connection with the information furnished by Haitian Consul BABUN in an effort to locate and seize the arms involved. On 10/29/64, Mr. SCHACTER advised that Customs investigation was continuing in connection with this matter.

On 10/24/64, SA JAMES KIRWAN, New York Office, advised that U. S. Customs, New York, was investigating the matter set forth in the CIA information report dated 10/23/64.

HENRIETTA LORI, CIA Covert, Miami, advised on 10/23/64 that CIA had no operational interest in any Haitian revolutionary activity, including the information which she furnished on 10/23/64, as set out in referenced Miami teletype 10/24/64.

ReBuairtel referenced a CIA intelligence information cable dated 10/19/64, captioned "Arrival in Miami of Cubans and Haitians to Join Haitian Exile Activist Group 'Combat.'" Miami unable to locate this communication and it could therefore not be included in the enclosed letterhead memorandum.

The following are the informants mentioned in the enclosed letterhead memorandum:

MM T-5 is FRANCISCO RODRIGUEZ TAMAYO, concealed per his request.

Miami will maintain contact with MM 639-S and other appropriate sources to follow developments in this matter.
