It is also pointed out to Jacksonville that the subject in his interview of December 21, 1962, advised he was in charge of Precincts 1, 2, 13, 18 and 19 in Havana. Included in this report is information furnished by LUIS G. MELLADO and ERNESTO PEREZ CARILLO, that the subject was also in charge of the 10th Precinct in Havana. [Also information furnished by MM T-1 on December 12, 1962 indicates the subject was with the 6th and 9th Precincts in Havana.] ~~(S)~~ ~~(C)~~ (U)

Subject, in his interview of December 21, 1962, denied membership in the July 26th Movement in Cuba. On January 28, 1963, ANGEL MARIA HERNANDEZ advised he was certain the subject was a member of the July 26th Movement in Cuba, and REINALDO PICO, on January 25, 1963, stated that subject was probably a member of this movement in Cuba.

The interview of December 2, 1962, with the subject, as set out in part in this report, is recorded on an FD-302.
