MM 509-C-TE also advised that JAMES PALMISANO (MM 92-503) and some of his associates at the County Social and Bridge Club, are backing DICK WILLIAMS in the opening of the Casa Linda Restaurant, 1432 Drewel Ave., Miami Beach. WILLIAMS is a dealer in the gambling games at the County Social and Bridge Club, and while he is dealing at the club, his wife handles the restaurant operation.
