For the information of the Miami Office, Dr. ERNESTO ARAGON, PSI-underdevelopment (protect), who is Secretary to DR. JOSE MIRO CARDONA, President of the Cuban Revolutionary Council (CRC), advised on 5/10/62, that he could furnish no information concerning the raising of funds by subject's group in NYC. (S) (u)

DR. ARAGON, however, furnished the following information concerning subject and the Second National Front of Escambray: He advised that the Second Front Escambray Group headed by the subject is in no way connected with the CRC. (S) (u)

DR. ARAGON advised that the group headed by the subject believes that they are being given the "brush-off" by Mr. CARDONA and the CRC. ARAGON stated that MIRO CARDONA had had discussion with subject only because CARDONA had been requested to do so by Mr. ROBERT HURWITCH of the US Department of State. HURWITCH had asked MIRO CARDONA to keep in contact with subject's group in order to know what they were doing or what they intended to do relative to military action in Cuba. ARAGON stated that MIRO CARDONA does not want the subject and his group as friends, nor on the other hand does he want them as enemies. (S) (u)

ARAGON advised that Dr. MIRO CARDONA has a CIA contact in Miami, Fla., and the CIA contact, whose identity is known to the NYO, has been in direct contact with subject's group. In discussing the subject's group with his CIA contact, MIRO CARDONA learned, according to ARAGON, that CIA does not like this group but believes that it could be used at times for certain specific jobs. MIRO CARDONA, therefore, concluded that although the Second Front Escambray is not being directed by CIA, they are called upon at times to do some particular mission for them. (\*) (u)
