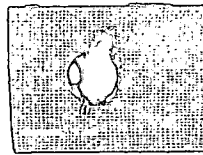
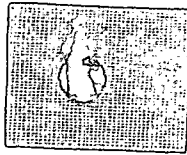

Alpha 66 is anti-Castro organization which has been conducting raids against Cuba. Included in its activities was attack against three vessels in Cuban waters in September, 1962, one of which was British freighter.

Andrew St. George, "Life" magazine free-lance photographer who recently accompanied Alpha 66 on a foray, advised that Alpha 66 utilized Anguilla Key, British possession in Bahamas, as point of departure for expeditions. This data being furnished Attorney General and interested agencies on 12/11/62.

Current information indicates split has developed within Alpha 66 with result that one portion of organization has retained name Alpha 66 while other has adopted name "L-66." CIA on 11/15/62 advised it acquired operational interest in dissident faction of Alpha 66 but noted it was only exploring potential future use of dissident faction and as of 11/15/62 was not furnishing any financial support, guidance or instructions. On 11/26/62 Army advised it had no operational interest per se in Alpha 66 as organization but had used some of its members and leaders as sources of information.

Information indicating Alpha 66 has been mounting its raids from Anguilla Key would be of particular interest to British.

(c) If you approve, the attached memorandum will be furnished the British advising them that we have learned that Anguilla Key in the Bahamas is being used as point of departure by Alpha 66 in its expeditions against Cuba. Andrew St. George as a source of this information is not being revealed. British also being advised of recent split that has occurred within Alpha 66.
