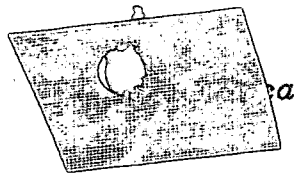
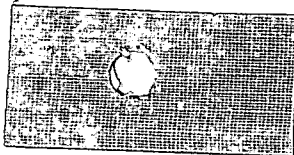

NOTE: On 6-17-58 Lieutenant Vila of Cuban Army Military Intelligence Service advised he read an article in a Miami, Florida, Spanish-language newspaper, 6-15-58 edition, stating that the subject, an American, was a member of the insurrectionary forces of Fidel Castro and fighting against the Batista Government. Lt. Vila stated that the Cuban military authorities were interested in obtaining any background data available and stated he would appreciate any assistance the Havana Office could give him in this matter. Havana suggested that Miami be requested to make inquiry concerning the subject's background. This is being done. The attached article contains information concerning one William A. Morgan, who appears to be identical with the subject. There appears to be no objection to furnishing this public source data to the Cuban military authorities.
