

Both RENE VALDES and GEORGE NOBREGAS of the Ministry of Interior, as well as HAV-32, have advised that RAMIRO VALDEZ is the most important police official in Cuba at the present time. RAMIRO VALDEZ has actual supervision of all organizations attempting any type of intelligence investigations.

RENE VALDES voluntarily stated that almost all members of G-2 are violently anti-American in their statements.

Colonel Kail, Army Attache, advised Legat he had learned that RAMIRO VALDEZ is very seldom in his office but spends almost his complete time in the company of RAUL CASTRO, head of the Cuban Armed Forces.

Legat will attempt to follow this matter closely and advise the Bureau immediately of any developments with respect to police relations.

With respect to information furnished by Colonel Kail in paragraph 1 of this letter, it will be appreciated if this information is not disseminated outside the Bureau as it was furnished the Legat in confidence.
