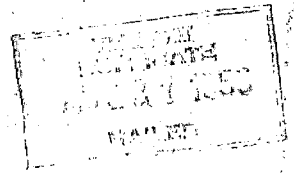
For information of Legat, Havana, Raiola, on advice of his superior in Monroe County Sheriff's office, has now decided not to undertake trip to Cuba. However, Raiola maintaining contact with subjects in effort to learn their plans. There have been some indications Roper may travel to Cuba in connection with this matter.

Miami should continue to maintain close contact with Raiola as to the outcome of his future meetings with subjects. Miami should also afford closest coverage possible, consistent with discretion, to both subjects in effort to determine their future contacts and activities with respect to the proposed intelligence assignment in Cuba. Possibility should be borne in mind that subjects will seek to recruit another individual, possibly some other law enforcement officer in Florida with whom they are acquainted, to perform this mission. Miami should utilize spot check surveillances on subjects, where warranted, and should also place appropriate stops so that we will be apprised of any travel subjects may make to Cuba.
