The Diplomatic List for June, 1961, Department of State publication 7210, shows Mr. Justo Sierra to be Counselor of the Mexican Embassy (6)

With regard to the practice of law in Hexico City on the part of Justo Sierra Casasus, A foreign source in 1943 advised that one Justo Sierra had a law office in Mexico, D.F. (5) with one Jack Oskerman and one Victor Mayo not otherwise (5) identified. A source of information who had furnished reliable information in the past reported that in 1946 one Justo Sierra (5) was the attorney of Merry Fahrney as American expatriate in Mexico City. [Merry Fahrney] had associated with prominent(5) Mazis and suspected Mozi agents (2065-44570-37) (65-25864-170)

Should any information come to the attention of this Bureau indicating any relationship between the present Counselor of the Mexican Embassy, Vashington, D.C., and Nicolas Georges (5) Damascus, his sister, Soviet agents or representatives of Castro, you will be notified (2)

The logic of all this is not too apparent
