Reference is made to information received concerning radio messages transmitted from Cuba to unidentified agents in the Caribbean area. The following was furnished to the Liaison Agent on November 7, 1962, by Jack Wallen, CIA. (S) (u)

With regard to "Roberto" this individual may be identical with Roberto Romero Adams, a Cuban negro-Mexican, born January 11, 1918, Havana, and currently residing at Isabel La Catolica 300-2, Mexico, D.F. This individual entered Mexico in 1941 and obtained immigrant status in 1950. His wife is Carmen Gonzalez Islas Romero. Romero is also known as "El Negro Flamenco." He has been in contact with Ernesto Rodriguez Cue, a Cuban G-2. He is also a long-time friend of Eusebio Azcue Lopez, a Cuban Consul in Mexico City. Romero's wife operates a gift shop called "Regalos Adams" located at Delicias 11, Mexico, D.F. Romero is employed by "Destribuidora Franco S. A.," a radio and T.V. store located at Tiber 22, Mexico City. (S) (u)

On or about October 20 through a cut-out, CIA conducted a neighborhood check of Romero. One of the neighbors stated that Romero has a radio in his apartment. CIA makes reference to the message which mentioned Scotland Yard. The agency now speculates that the above-described neighborhood investigation may have been the basis for the radio message reference to "Scotland Yard." Since this is possible, CIA for the time being is not requesting NSA to make the particular message available to the [British] (S)
