The material furnished by former MAV-4 was deemed of sufficient importance to be furnished CIA And State Department for an evaluation of its contents. The names of the persons involved were also furnished, as a proper evaluation could not be made without the identities of the leaders being known. It is believed the above instructions by the Bureau to CIA And a State will insure the proper handling of the information in order to adequately protect the source's identity. We are also not in a position to guarantee HAV-4 that we will not pass on the identities of persons involved, at least to other U. S. Government agencies, inasmuch as material could be of such extreme importance that their identities must be known in order for this Government to evaluate same.

In view of HAV-4's present location in Venezuela, you should not enter into any relationship with him whereby he would feel he is once again being operated and directed by the Bureau. It is also not feasible for a representative of the Bureau to meet HAV-4 in Venezuela.

This letter is classified "Confidential" as it contains material furnished by a former source of continuing value, the disclosure of whom could jeopardize his future effectiveness.

Former HAV-4, currently a resident of Venezuela, furnished data regarding establishment of a new political group of professional and business men in that country to combat communism. HAV-4 also indicated that members of this group desired to cooperate with FBI in furnishing material regarding Venezuela. He was advised that Bureau could not enter into such a relationship but if persons from group came to U. S. on business, Miami Office would accept any data they desired to furnish. HAV-4 also expressed desire to meet Bureau representative in Venezuela to furnish data regarding Venezuela but this is not feasible. Believed material of sufficient interest to request evaluation of it by CIA and State.

 $\rm HAV-4$ advised the above group had no confidence in CIA $\,$ or the U. S. Embassy in Caracas and did not desire to deal with them
