Liaison was requested to determine the nature and extent of Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) past or present relationship with the subject. (S)(u)

On October 30, 1960, Mrs. Jane Roman, CIA, advised that the subject had been utilized by CIA in Cuba as a source of information. She was discontinued as a source after she came to the U.S. several months ago. The agency has no plan for any future use of Guerra. (S)(u)

CIA has no derogatory information concerning her and she was characterized as a routine type of source. (S)(u)
