SOURCE OF INFORMATION - CUBA

Reference is made to memorandum dated 9/3/63, from Mr. Wannall to Mr. Sullivan. Liaison was instructed to review with CIA the subject's relationship with Margarita Madrazo, to pass on to CIA subject's observations concerning Madrazo, inform CIA that we would like to have the subject contact Raul Roa, Jr., in Brazil and that the subject would be made available to CIA for a briefing prior to his departure. The Liaison Agent was also instructed to explore with CIA steps which could be taken to prevent Madrazo from interfering with or jeopardizing this operation.

A preliminary discussion concerning this matter was held with Austin Horn, CIA, on 9/6/63, at which time Horn stated it would be necessary to confer with certain CIA officials. On 9/12/63, the Liaison Agent met with Al Rodriguez and as a result of the discussion wheld, Rodriguez made the following statements:

> CIA believes that subject's trip to Brazil could be worthwhile and there appears to be nothing to lose. CIA believes that the chances of promoting a defection of Roa, Jr., are slim but the subject possibly could develop information of interest.

If the subject travels to Brazil, CIA would like to brief him prior to his departure. If subject so desires, CIA will brief him in Washington, D.C., and the Agency will be willing to pay his traveling expenses from Salt Lake City to Washington, D.C. These expenses would also cover his return trip to Salt Lake City in the event subject found it necessary to return to Utah prior to his departure for Brazil.

- 3. In Brazil, CIA would plan to have some contact with subject since this could be necessary in order to give him a channel for any assistance he may need and at the same time CIA would be in a position to furnish him any last minute briefing.
- 4. At this point, CIA does not feel that it should cover subject's travel to and from Brazil. In the opinion of the Agency, the expenses to be incurred for such a trip do not seem to be warranted.
- 5. CIA would like to debrief the subject upon his return from Brazil.
- 6. As far as CIA is concerned, the Agency will have no reason to have Margarita Madrazo become involved in any aspects of this matter. CIA suggested that, if possible, the subject not make any stop in Miami where Madrazo is currently located.
