On 11/24/60. WF 1133-Se advised that subject contacted Dr. ARMANDO FLOREZ, Cuban Charge d' Affaires ad interim, from Baltimore, Maryland, to advise that he had agreed to meet and talk with Ambassador QUINTIN PINO MACHADO and DIMAS CID, Cuban Attache, at 5:30 p.m., on 11/24/60, in Baltimore. Upon arrival at the appointed place, the office of the physician brother of his fiancee (DIANA LUZ BERRIOS), MARTINEZ found a note left by PINO indicating that the latter and DIMAS CID had been there but had departed since subject had failed to make an appearance. MACHADO indicated to FLOREZ that he was very interested in speaking with these "two comrades" and asked FLOREZ to tell them to call him on the night of 11/24/60 or on 11/25/60, at the telephone number AT 8-3185 in Baltimore. In discussion with FLOREZ, the latter commented to subject that everybody else at the Cuban Embassy, including FLOREZ, himself, are "comrades"

of the subject in the revolution. According to the informant, FLOREZ furnished the above information from the subject to Commander JOSE HOLEON CARRERA, Cuban Hilltory and Air Attache, and notified MOLEON of the telephone number in Baltimore, where HARTINEZ could be located.

on 11/25/60, WF 1134-59 advised that the subject was by physically present in the prepises occupied by the Cuban Embassy in Washington, D. C. The above informant advised further that reservations were made for the subject and JOSE MOLEON to leave Washington Mational Airport at 12:20 p.m., on 11/25/60, for New York, New York. That flight was due to arrive there at 1:40 p.m. The informant advised further that reservations were made for the above individuals to leave New York, for Havans, Cuba, on Cubana Airlines flight leaving Idlovild Airport at 3:30 p.m., on 11/25/60.

CD 11/25/60. CPSI; whose identity must be protected and who should be characterized as having furnished reliable information in the past) telephonically advised SA GERARD C. CARROLL that subject was present at the Embacusy of Cuba Guring the morning of 11/25/60, in the office of FLOREZ. He was visited and presumably questioned in this office by FLOREZ, Holkon, CID, PINO and an unidentified friend of PINO. According to PSI, EARTINEZ was still in the office of FLOREZ at 12:30 p.m., on 11/25/60. PSI advised that MOLEON left the necting with MARTINEZ during mid-morning and reportedly was leaving immediately for Havana, Cuba.

PSI stated that DIANA LUZ BERRIOS, subject's girl friend, telephonically contacted MARTINES at the Cuban Embassy during the early morning of 11/25/60, and later personally visited the Cuban Embassy at approximately 11:00 or 11:30 a.m.

According to the above described PSI, a tage recorder was brought into FLAREZ's room during the interrogation of the subject and FLOREZ had called GLADYS ZAHORA, Secretary in the Office of the Cuban Military and Air Attache, to assist him in the mechanical operation of this machine.
