**SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:**

*you*

JOHN HOWARD LAWSON resides at 9354 Burnet Avenue, San Fernando, California. He derives his livelihood from lectures he gives under the auspices of the Hollywood Arts, Sciences, and Professions Council and from the sale of his book "The Hidden Heritage." He continues to be very active in the affairs of the Hollywood Arts, Sciences and Professions Council of which he is a member of the Executive Board. [In June, 1952, he attended a National Board meeting of the Arts, Sciences and Professions Council at New York City and presented a draft for discussion which charged that "our freedoms are being destroyed." In his lectures under the auspices of the Hollywood Arts, Sciences and Professions Council, LAWSON has consistently praised the arts and sciences existing in the USSR while he has charged the leaders and officials of the United States with being imperialists, fascists, anti-Semites and followers of the Malthusian doctrine. He was a featured speaker before a function of the Veterans of the Abraham Lincoln Brigade in May, 1952 and attended a dinner sponsored by the Los Angeles Negro Labor Council held in April, 1952. He subscribes to the Daily Worker and was a reference for a person applying for membership in the Communist Party in February, 1952. On August 7, 1952, LAWSON was the featured speaker at a mass meeting held to protest the conviction of the 14 California Communist Party leaders under the Smith Act of 1940.
