Confidential Informant ND 426 advised on March 15, 1944 that IAWSON was Secretary of the American Society for Technical Aid to Spanish Democracy in February, 1937. ND 426 advised on November 6, 1943, that LAWSON served as a member of the Max/Bedacht Birthday Committee.
