Dear Mr. Innes:

This has reference to your letter dated May 18, 1961 concerning Joseph Howard LAWSON and Sue LAWSON, Internal Security - C, your file 100-1294.

2. We have now been advised a search of the list of passengers who sailed from Montreal, Quebec, on board the M.V. "Batory" at 12:30 P.M. on May 17, 1961 revealed the names of Mr. and Mrs. J.H. LAWSON as passengers on this ship. They occupied cabin #21, and held ticket # 5418, with their port of disembarkation shown as Gdynia, Poland.

3. The LAWSONs did not come to our adverse notice while in Canada.
