LAWSON's letter indicated that while he is continuing his work on his book on the theory of film art, it is not progressing as fast as he would like; however, he expects it to be ready for the publishers by 1963. Both LAWSON and his wife have had health problems during the past year. He says his wife suffered a mild heart attack last winter in Moscow and had to be hospitalized. himself has a gallbladder operation which resulted in postoperation hernia. LAWSON spoke in glowing terms of the care hospital cases receive in the Soviet Union.
