

Dear Tony,

You can be of great service to me in a very desperate situation.

If Phil is available and willing (and I hope he will be), have him contact his former employers and tell them that I have been trying to get in touch with them discreetly for several weeks. A letter was even sent to their Cuban Affairs Section in the hope it would reach the right person. So far there has been no answer from them and time is running out on me. (3)

Frankly, this is a matter of life or death, so do you best to have Phil contact his former employers. They should make only the most discreet contacts with me here in New York, so that we can arrange a meeting — I suggest Montreal because I often have had business there and it is out of the country. I believe that I can be of extreme value to them and I know that, if they are willing, they can be of great help to me in a very difficult situation.

PLEASE KEEP THIS STRICTLY TO YOURSELF AND PHIL AND DO NOT MENTION IT TO ANYONE ELSE. Destroy this letter when you have read it.

Phil's former employers can contact me at this address almost any afternoon. You can call me collect at this number or at my home phone (YU 2-6011), but watch what you say over the phone. One other thing: I'll be in Conway, N.H. from April 23 to 27, but I can be reached by phone at the World Fellowship Center there.

Many thanks for your aid. Someday I'll be able to explain more about this to you, but, again, I ask you to be absolutely secretive about this manner of the depends on it!
