Residence and Employment

On August 10, 1962, NY T-1 advised that subject resides at 37½ St. Mark's Place, New York, New York, in Apartment 3E and continues to be Acting National Executive Secretary of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC). 4

A characterization of the FPCC appears in the Appendix attached hereto. 4

On May 29, 1962, NY T-2, another government agency, advised that they had learned that subject had furnished the address of ANDRE MARTINSONS, 297 East 10th Street, New York City, as a safe address for people in Central and South America to use in communicating with him. (S)(u)

According to information furnished by NY T-14, <sup>NY</sup> ANDRE MARTINSONS is a former full time employee of the FPCC. (S)(u)

On May 24, 1962, NY T-1 advised that subject told him on May 23, 1962, that he had a press card as a United Nations (UN) correspondent for "Bohemia", a Cuban magazine. (u) (S)

Connections with the FPCC

On May 11, 1962, NY T-3 advised that at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the FPCC in Chicago, Illinois, it was announced that subject had written a letter urging the group to cooperate in any action in opposition to the House Committee for Un-American Activities. (S)(u)

On May 22, 1962, NY T-4 advised that at a meeting at Casa Cuba on May 16, 1962, (S)(u)

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
