Informant said he is quite sure that since the defection of YURI NOSENKO, Colonel BORIS S. IVANOV has received explicit instructions from KGB headquarters in Moscow regarding the tightening up of security in the NY Residency, and has undoubtedly passed these instructions on to his deputies.

On 2/19/64, informant was talking to VLADIMIR CHUCHUKIN concerning the above mentioned security precautions which are now in effect in the KGB NY Residency. CHUCHUKIN told the informant it seems to him that all the employees of the KGB NY Residency are somewhat surprised at these new regulations. CHUCHUKIN said he can well understand why these regulations are put into effect, namely, to maintain the best security possible in the KGB NY Residency. He said, however, that he considers the new method of handling correspondence from Moscow to be most unwieldy and he predicted that as soon as tensions relax somewhat, the residency will be back to its former methods of operation. CHUCHUKIN said that if GABELKO and the heads of the other branches in the NY Residency vigorously pursue the policy of "snipping up" the film containing correspondence from Moscow, and handing it out to the individual KGB employees, they will soon lose track of the correspondence and will be in a worse administrative predicament than before they started this new arrangement.

Informant's Comments Concerning KGB
Agent Having the Code Name "CHARLES" (S)

On 2/19/64, VLADIMIR KARATSUBA was seated in the KGB space presently being utilized by employees of the STB. Informant said he could readily see that KARATSUBA was writing something concerning the KGB agent having the code name "CHARLES" inasmuch as informant could observe this name at the top of the page on which KARATSUBA was working.
