IGOR ANDREEV's Comments Concerning
YURI NOSENKO

NY airtel, 3/25/64, reflected that on 3/20/64, informant had received a letter from his friend, IGOR ANDREEV, who is presently employed in KGB headquarters in Moscow.

In addition to information in this letter, as set out in the above mentioned airtel, ANDREEV wrote that at the present time special committees are functioning in every directorate at KGB headquarters in Moscow for the specific purpose of trying to determine exactly who YURI NOSENKO knew among personnel of these various directorates. ANDREEV said that special emphasis in this matter is being placed on personnel of the First Main Directorate. ANDREEV commented that NOSENKO does not know him (ANDREEV).
