that PERFILEV's father and Colonel IVANOV were well known to each other, and were in actuality good friends. CHUCHUKIN said that despite the fact that PERFILEV had demolished a KGB automobile during his last tour of duty in the US, he would never have to answer for this because of this friendship between IVANOV and General PERFILEV. CHUCHUKIN also told the informant that YURI NOSENKO's father and the father of YURI PERFILEV were very good friends and, therefore, General PERFILEV was quite well acquainted with YURI NOSENKO.

It is noted that YURI N. PERFILEV was, according to Mosnat cards maintained in the NYO in the US during the period 8/21/61 to 9/17/61, and 6/13/62 to 5/6/64. He was an employee of the Russian Translation Section of the UN Secretariat.

Additional Information Concerning  
Relationship Developing Between  
VLADIMIR KARATSUBA and Employees  
of the UN Security Force —

Informant advised that on Thursday, 5/28/64, or Friday, 5/29/64, he went to the UN Secretariat in order to visit and talk to VLADIMIR KARATSUBA and EVGENI ERMAK. After reflecting on this briefly, informant said he was more inclined to believe that this was Friday, 5/29/64, than Thursday, 5/28/64, although he was not absolutely sure.

Informant said that when he got there he made a telephone call to the office of VLADIMIR KARATSUBA, and learned that KARATSUBA was absent from the UN at that time. He then telephoned EVGENI ERMAK, and upon talking with him, asked ERMAK to meet him in the 4th floor cafeteria in the UN Secretariat building. Informant said ERMAK countered this proposal by inviting informant to have a bloody mary with him instead. Informant said he accepted ERMAK's proposal.
