Reference is made to your communication captioned Soviet Personnel Intelligence Activities, Espionage - Russia; file number (S) 100-354839, of 22 October 1965, in which you request any additional information from SAMMY and other sources concerning Service Number 1 and Service Number 2 of the KGB First Chief Directorate. Other than SCOTCH, SAMMY has been our only Source of information on these two components of the KGB. His information is set forth below.

2. SAMMY has been able to report relatively little concerning Service Number 1, saying only that "recently" the former Information Department of the KGB First Chief Directorate was upgraded to the level of a "service" and was renamed Service Number 1. According to SAMMY, a "service" is on the same administrative level as a Directorate, which means that Service Number 1 is higher in status than a department and that the Chief of the Service Number 1 receives a higher salary than a department chief. This change was made, according to SAMMY, because it was necessary to expand the Information Department to include more people. He could not recall the name of the chief of Service Number 1 or of any of the officers assigned to it.

3. SAMMY has also reported that, in 1963, the Fourteenth (Counterintelligence) Department of the KGB First Chief Directorate was redesignated Service Number 2. Like its
