

A COMPLAINT FROM A CITIZEN, THE CAR WAS STRUCK BY PELLETS
FROM TWO SHOTGUN BLASTS. NO ONE WAS INJURED. A SECOND POLICE
CAR WAS DISPATCHED TO THE AREA AND NEGRO YOUTHS SHOUTED
OBSCENITIES AT THE OFFICERS.
