AGITATIONAL AND ANTIWAR ACTIVITY IN THE UNITED STATES.

AGITATION CONTINUED AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, TO PROTEST THE TRIALS OF THE EIGHT INDIVIDUALS INDICTED FOR THEIR ACTIVITIES DURING THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY (SDS) LEADERS ADDRESSED

APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS GATHERED OUTSIDE THE COURTHOUSE BERNARDINE DOHRN, AN SDS LEADER, WAS ARRESTED ON A PRIOR CHARGE OF ASSAULT. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST, TWENTY INDIVIDUALS APPEARED AT THE COURTHOUSE, BUT HELD NO DEMONSTRATION.

THE NEW ENGLAND COMMITTEE FOR NONVIOLENT ACTION SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION AT THE GENERAL DYNAMICS CORPORATION, GROTON, CONNECTICUT, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST DURING A VISIT TO THE AREA BY THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE. THE FIFTY SIX DEMONSTRATORS DISTRIBUTED LEAFLETS LISTING INDIVIDUALS FROM CONNECTICUT WHO HAVE BEEN KILLED IN VIETNAM.

WOMEN STRIKE FOR PEACE (WSP) PLANS TO DEMONSTRATE AT THE SHOREHAM HOTEL, WASHINGTON, D. C., ON OCTOBER NINE NEXT WHEN MRS. RICHARD NIXON ADDRESSES THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF JEWISH WOMEN. WSP IS PREPARING AN ANTIWAR TELEGRAM WHICH IT HOPES TO DELIVER TO MRS. NIXON AT THE SHOREHAM HOTEL. COPIES OF THE TELEGRAM WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO INDIVIDUALS ATTENDING THE MEETING.

SIX HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF THE YOUNG SOCIALIST ALLIANCE, SDS, AND THE SOUTHERN CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE (SCLC) DEMONSTRATED AT ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST TO PROTEST ALLEGED POLICE BRUTALITY. THE PRINCIPAL SPEAKER WAS HOSEA WILLIAMS, A LEADER OF THE SCLC. SPEAKERS DEMANDED THE REMOVAL OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

SDS SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION DURING A FACULTY MEETING AT HARVARD UNIVERSITY, CAMBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST TO PROTEST "PROJECT CAN," A PLAN TO DEVELOP A SCIENCE DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AT UNIVERSITIES IN THE BOSTON AREA. SPEAKERS CRITICIZED THE WAR IN VIETNAM AND CLAIMED THAT THIS PROJECT IS LINKED TO IT.

SDS SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION IN THE VICINITY OF WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY, DETROIT, MICHIGAN, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST. SPEAKERS SUPPORTED NORTH VIETNAM AND CONDEMNED THE UNITED STATES "RACIST IMPERIALIST SOCIETY." FOLLOWING THE SPEECHES, THE DEMONSTRATORS BEGAN RUNNING THROUGH NEARBY STREETS. NINE OF THEM WERE ARRESTED AND SEVEN POLICE OFFICERS WERE INJURED.

IT WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED THAT ONE HUNDRED DEMONSTRATORS WERE ARRESTED ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY FIVE LAST DURING A SIT-IN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN, ANN ARBOR, MICHIGAN. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, SDS SPONSORED A RALLY TO PROTEST THE ARRESTS. THE RALLY WAS ADDRESSED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY WHO STATED THAT UNIVERSITY AUTHORITIES WILL NOT MEET WITH THE DEMONSTRATORS UNDER CONDITIONS OF DURESS. SDS IS ATTEMPTING TO PROMOTE A STUDENT STRIKE.

THE TWIN CITY DRAFT INFORMATION CENTER SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION AT ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST DURING A VISIT TO THAT CITY BY GENERAL WILLIAM C. WESTMORELAND.

THE DEMONSTRATORS DISTRIBUTED LITERATURE CENSORING GENERAL WESTMORELAND AND DENOUNCING THE WAR IN VIETNAM.

IT WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED THAT THE ASSOCIATION OF BLACK COLLEGIANS WAS SUSPENDED AT FOREST PARK COMMUNITY COLLEGE, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, FOLLOWING DISRUPTIVE DEMONSTRATIONS. THE SCHOOL HAS BEEN CLOSED SINCE THAT TIME AND THE ASSOCIATION CONTINUED ITS AGITATION DEMANDING THAT ADDITIONAL NEGRO FACULTY MEMBERS BE HIRED, THAT THE ASSOCIATION BE GIVEN A WORKROOM, AND THAT IT BE REINSTATED. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY REINSTATED THE ASSOCIATION AND SCHOOL REOPENED TODAY.

THE WORKER/STUDENT ALLIANCE (WSA) FACTION OF SDS, WHICH IS CONTROLLED BY THE PROGRESSIVE LABOR PARTY, SPONSORED AN ANTIWAR DEMONSTRATION AT NEW YORK CITY ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST. THE TWO HUNDRED DEMONSTRATORS CARRIED SIGNS DEMANDING THAT THE UNITED STATES IMMEDIATELY WITHDRAW FROM VIETNAM. THE DEMONSTRATION WAS DISRUPTED BY TWENTY DEMONSTRATORS FROM THE STUDENT LIBERATION FRONT CARRYING A BANNER DEMANDING THE UNITED STATES GET OUT OF VIETNAM AND URGING SUPPORT FOR THE DEMONSTRATIONS AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, OCTOBER EIGHT THROUGH ELEVEN NEXT. POLICE KEPT THE OPPOSING GROUPS APART. WSA SPEAKERS STATED THAT IT WILL NOT SUPPORT THE OCTOBER DEMONSTRATIONS IN CHICAGO AS THE NATIONAL OFFICE FACTION OF SDS WANTS VIOLENCE.

TWO HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS DEMONSTRATED IN THE VICINITY OF THE FARGO, NORTH DAKOTA, CIVIC AUDITORIUM ON THE EVENING OF SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST DURING A SPEECH BY THE VICE PRESIDENT. THE DEMONSTRATORS REMAINED IN THE VICINITY OF THE CIVIC AUDITORIUM FOR SEVERAL HOURS READING THE NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS KILLED IN VIETNAM.

ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, ONE HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS WERE PRESENT DURING THE SENTENCING OF AN INDIVIDUAL AT SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO, FOR A VIOLATION OF THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT. UPON LEAVING THE COURTHOUSE, THE DEMONSTRATORS PROCEEDED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF PUERTO RICO WHERE THREE HUNDRED FIFTY OF THEM GATHERED AT THE RESERVE OFFICERS TRAINING CORPS (ROTC) BUILDING. SEVERAL OF THE DEMONSTRATORS ENTERED THE ROTC BUILDING, SCATTERED FILES, DESTROYED PAPERS, AND SET SEVERAL FIRES. SEVERAL FIREMEN WERE INJURED BY ROCKS THROWN BY THE DEMONSTRATORS. AN AMERICAN FLAG WAS BURNED DURING THE DEMONSTRATION. DAMAGES TO THE ROTC BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT ARE ESTIMATED AT TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS.

SDS DEMONSTRATED ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST AT SEATTLE, WASHINGTON. THE TWENTY DEMONSTRATORS CARRIED A VIET CONG FLAG AND SPRAYED BUILDINGS WITH RED AND BLUE PAINT. ONE DEMONSTRATOR WAS ARRESTED.

AGITATIONAL AND ANTIWAR ACTIVITY IN THE UNITED STATES.

AGITATION CONTINUED AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, TO PROTEST THE TRIALS OF THE EIGHT INDIVIDUALS INDICTED FOR THEIR ACTIVITIES DURING THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY (SDS) LEADERS ADDRESSED

APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS GATHERED OUTSIDE THE COURTHOUSE BERNARDINE DOHRN, AN SDS LEADER, WAS ARRESTED ON A PRIOR CHARGE OF ASSAULT. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST, TWENTY INDIVIDUALS APPEARED AT THE COURTHOUSE, BUT HELD NO DEMONSTRATION.

THE NEW ENGLAND COMMITTEE FOR NONVIOLENT ACTION SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION AT THE GENERAL DYNAMICS CORPORATION, GROTON, CONNECTICUT, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST DURING A VISIT TO THE AREA BY THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE. THE FIFTY SIX DEMONSTRATORS DISTRIBUTED LEAFLETS LISTING INDIVIDUALS FROM CONNECTICUT WHO HAVE BEEN KILLED IN VIETNAM.

WOMEN STRIKE FOR PEACE (WSP) PLANS TO DEMONSTRATE AT THE SHOREHAM HOTEL, WASHINGTON, D. C., ON OCTOBER NINE NEXT WHEN MRS. RICHARD NIXON ADDRESSES THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF JEWISH WOMEN. WSP IS PREPARING AN ANTIWAR TELEGRAM WHICH IT HOPES TO DELIVER TO MRS. NIXON AT THE SHOREHAM HOTEL. COPIES OF THE TELEGRAM WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO INDIVIDUALS ATTENDING THE MEETING.

SIX HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF THE YOUNG SOCIALIST ALLIANCE, SDS, AND THE SOUTHERN CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE (SCLC)

DEMONSTRATED AT ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST TO PROTEST ALLEGED POLICE BRUTALITY. THE PRINCIPAL SPEAKER WAS ROSEA WILLIAMS, A LEADER OF THE SCLC. SPEAKERS DEMANDED THE REMOVAL OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

SDS SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION DURING A FACULTY MEETING AT HARVARD UNIVERSITY, CAMBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST TO PROTEST "PROJECT CAM," A PLAN TO DEVELOP A SCIENCE DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AT UNIVERSITIES IN THE BOSTON AREA. SPEAKERS CRITICIZED THE WAR IN VIETNAM AND CLAIMED THAT THIS PROJECT IS LINKED TO IT.

SDS SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION IN THE VICINITY OF WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY, DETROIT, MICHIGAN, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST. SPEAKERS SUPPORTED NORTH VIETNAM AND CONDEMNED THE UNITED STATES "RACIST IMPERIALIST SOCIETY." FOLLOWING THE SPEECHES, THE DEMONSTRATORS BEGAN RUNNING THROUGH NEARBY STREETS. NINE OF THEM WERE ARRESTED AND SEVEN POLICE OFFICERS WERE INJURED.

IT WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED THAT ONE HUNDRED DEMONSTRATORS WERE ARRESTED ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY FIVE LAST DURING A SIT-IN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN, ANN ARBOR, MICHIGAN. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, SDS SPONSORED A RALLY TO PROTEST THE ARRESTS. THE RALLY WAS ADDRESSED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY WHO STATED THAT UNIVERSITY AUTHORITIES WILL NOT MEET WITH THE DEMONSTRATORS UNDER CONDITIONS OF DURESS. SDS IS ATTEMPTING TO PROMOTE A STUDENT STRIKE.

THE TWIN CITY DRAFT INFORMATION CENTER SPONSORED A DEMONSTRATION AT ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA, ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST DURING A VISIT TO THAT CITY BY GENERAL WILLIAM C. WESTMORELAND.

THE DEMONSTRATORS DISTRIBUTED LITERATURE CENSORING GENERAL WESTMORELAND AND DENOUNCING THE WAR IN VIETNAM.

IT WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED THAT THE ASSOCIATION OF BLACK COLLEGIANS WAS SUSPENDED AT FOREST PARK COMMUNITY COLLEGE, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, FOLLOWING DISRUPTIVE DEMONSTRATIONS. THE SCHOOL HAS BEEN CLOSED SINCE THAT TIME AND THE ASSOCIATION CONTINUED ITS AGITATION DEMANDING THAT ADDITIONAL NEGRO FACULTY MEMBERS BE HIRED, THAT THE ASSOCIATION BE GIVEN A WORKROOM, AND THAT IT BE REINSTATED. ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY REINSTATED THE ASSOCIATION AND SCHOOL REOPENED TODAY.

THE WORKER/STUDENT ALLIANCE (WSA) FACTION OF SDS, WHICH IS CONTROLLED BY THE PROGRESSIVE LABOR PARTY, SPONSORED AN ANTIWAR DEMONSTRATION AT NEW YORK CITY ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST. THE TWO HUNDRED DEMONSTRATORS CARRIED SIGNS DEMANDING THAT THE UNITED STATES IMMEDIATELY WITHDRAW FROM VIETNAM. THE DEMONSTRATION WAS DISRUPTED BY TWENTY DEMONSTRATORS FROM THE STUDENT LIBERATION FRONT CARRYING A BANNER DEMANDING THE UNITED STATES GET OUT OF VIETNAM AND URSING SUPPORT FOR THE DEMONSTRATIONS AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, OCTOBER EIGHT THROUGH ELEVEN NEXT. POLICE KEPT THE OPPOSING GROUPS APART. WSA SPEAKERS STATED THAT IT WILL NOT SUPPORT THE OCTOBER DEMONSTRATIONS IN CHICAGO AS THE NATIONAL OFFICE FACTION OF SDS WANTS VIOLENCE.

TWO HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS DEMONSTRATED IN THE VICINITY OF THE FARGO, NORTH DAKOTA, CIVIC AUDITORIUM ON THE EVENING OF SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST DURING A SPEECH BY THE VICE PRESIDENT. THE DEMONSTRATORS REMAINED IN THE VICINITY OF THE CIVIC AUDITORIUM FOR SEVERAL HOURS READING THE NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS KILLED IN VIETNAM.

ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST, ONE HUNDRED INDIVIDUALS WERE PRESENT DURING THE SENTENCING OF AN INDIVIDUAL AT SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO, FOR A VIOLATION OF THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT. UPON LEAVING THE COURTHOUSE, THE DEMONSTRATORS PROCEEDED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF PUERTO RICO WHERE THREE HUNDRED FIFTY OF THEM GATHERED AT THE RESERVE OFFICERS TRAINING CORPS (ROTC) BUILDING. SEVERAL OF THE DEMONSTRATORS ENTERED THE ROTC BUILDING, SCATTERED FILES, DESTROYED PAPERS, AND SET SEVERAL FIRES. SEVERAL FIREMEN WERE INJURED BY ROCKS THROWN BY THE DEMONSTRATORS. AN AMERICAN FLAG WAS BURNED DURING THE DEMONSTRATION. DAMAGES TO THE ROTC BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT ARE ESTIMATED AT TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS.

SDS DEMONSTRATED ON SEPTEMBER TWENTY SEVEN LAST AT SEATTLE, WASHINGTON. THE TWENTY DEMONSTRATORS CARRIED A VIET CONG FLAG AND SPRAYED BUILDINGS WITH RED AND BLUE PAINT. ONE DEMONSTRATOR WAS ARRESTED.
