1. AS RESULT PICKUP BY BRITISH OF 9 CTRANS AT CAY SAL ON
 29 NOV SCOTE REQUESTED BRIEF MEETING WHICH HELD 30 NOV
 MEETING SCOTE REVEALED THAT LOS US COAST GUARD DISTRICT 7 HAD
 SENT SECRET OPERATIONAL MESSAGE ON 28 NOV TO BRITISH COAST SEA
 AND AIR UNITS REPEATED TO EMS TARTAR, JOINT STAFF NASSAU, US
 CONSUL NASSAU, AND RETRANSMITTED BY JOINT STAFF NASSAU TO BRFL.
 MESSAGE INCLUDED DETAILS OF INTL REPORTS OF EXILE GROUPS PLANNING
 INCREASED ACTIVITIES IN NEAR FUTURE INCLUDING:

A. ALPHA C3 AND OMEGA PLAN TO EXECUTE THEIR PLAN OMEGA
 AN INFILTRATION MISSION INVOLVING SABOTAGE IN CUBA AND
 ORIGINATING IN PANAMA, YUCATAN AND SAFTO (MEXICO ON THE
 GULF COAST COULD INDICATED LITTLE IMMEDIATE COAST GUARD
 ACTION INDICATED).

B. DETAILS OF WAVE 1343 (IN 63493) OF COMANDOS I
 PLAN TO ATTACK COAST SHIPPING IN CUBAN WATERS USING 3
 BOATS AND 10 MEN. IN ADDITION TO DETAILS IN WAVE REPORT,
 COAST GUARD ARMED STATIONERY THAT ATTACK MAY POSSIBLY BE
 STAGED FROM ALABAMA BAY AND ABOUT 10 NAMES OF PEOPLE

 DETAILS OF INFO DATED 18 APR RE COMANDOS L HAVING 4 SUPPLY
 BOATS AND 4 OPERATIONAL BOATS

C. INFO IN WAVE 8247 (IN 69483) RE COMANDOS LIBRES
 PLAN TO HIJACK A SHIP AT SEA. COAST GUARD ALSO ADDED 10
 NAMES OF PERSONS PREVIOUSLY ASSOCIATED WITH THIS GROUP.

2. COAST GUARD MESSAGE THEM ADVISED RE ARE OF COAST GUARD
 PATROLS INCLUDING REQUEST TO JOINT STAFF NA/SAU THAT BRITISH
 GUARDSHIP (HMS TANTAR) COMPLETE COAST GUARD PATROL EFFORTS BY
 GIVING SURFACE COVERAGE FROM ANQUILLA EASTWARD TO CAY LOROS

3. BRITISH BOTH SURPRISED AND PLEASED WITH EXTENT OF INFO
 PASSED BY COAST GUARD. SMOTE HOWEVER POINTS OUT THAT BRITISH WOULD
 PREFER SUCH INFO TO BE PASSED TO SMOTE IN WAVE RATHER THAN DIRECTLY
 FROM COAST GUARD TO NA/SAU. SMOTE SAID THEY OF COURSE UNDERSTOOD
 THAT URGENCY OF INFO, INCLUDING THANKSGIVING DAY HOLIDAY, MADE FOR
 DIRECT PASSAGE. HQS DID NOT ATTEMPT TO DISABUSE SMOTE OF THIS IDEA.

4. IT APPARENT FROM ABOVE THAT COAST GUARD HAS PASSED
 DIRECTLY TO BRITISH, WAVE INFO CLEARLY MARKED AS CONTROLLED DISSEM
 AND NO FOREIGN DISSEM. REQUEST WAVE DISCUSS SUBJECT WITH APPROPRIATE

COAST GUARD OFFICERS TO ENFORCE ADHERENCE TO CLASSIFICATIONS AND TO
PREVENT LOS PASS SUCH INFO TO ENEMY IN WASH. FBI LOS WOULD NOT
USUALLY HAVE PASSED THESE SPECIFIC WAVE REPORTS SINCE THERE WAS NO
INDICATION THAT BRITISH TERRITORY PER SE WOULD BE USED IN THESE
PARTICULAR EXILE ACTIVITIES.

5. IT CLEAR FROM EVENTS ON 29 NOV AND FACT THAT BRITISH
STATE THEY HAVE LOIS AGUIAR AS ONE OF 9 BEING HELD THAT COAST GUARD
DID NOT PICK UP GROUP REPORTED IN WAVE 8218 (IN 60206) WAVE 4140
PRIOR DEPARTURE FLORIDA WATERS AS REPORTED PARA III, WAVE 8362 (IN
70041). ACCORDING INFO AVAILABLE LOS BOAT SLIPPED PAST COAST GUARD
WAS THEN SPOTTED BY COAST GUARD AIRCRAFT WHO NOTIFIED BRITISH IN
TIME FOR THEM TO ABANDON BOAT. LOS LATER THEN, AFTER SEARCHING
CAY SAL, FOUND ARMS AND AMMUNITION CACHE. HAVE ADVISED BROWN GARDEN
UNDER SURVEILLANCE AND THAT BOAT WHICH DESTROYED BY LOS TARTAR NOT
CONNECTED WITH KUBARK.

6. FBI ONLY: STILL HAVE NOT HAD WORD FROM LOND ON PROPOSED
BRITISH PROCEDURES RE ACTIVITIES KUBARK MARITIME FRONT. BOTH LOS
AND BROWN WILL HAVE BEEN PENDING FOR DECISION AS WAS CONVEYER OF

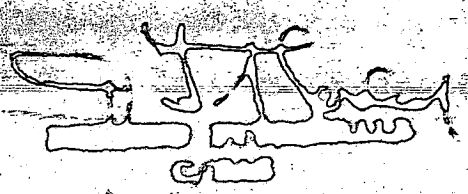
