According to LIFIRE report, Boleslaw JELEN, Polish Ambassador to Cuba, arrived in Mexico from Cuba on 30 September 1963 and departed Mexico for Warsaw via Sabana on 2 October 1963. LIFIRE reports indicate that subject was returning PCS to Warsaw, his wife having preceded him to Poland in May 1963.
