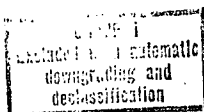
### Summary of Developments

1. There have been no significant new developments in the LITABBY Project since reference A, the Station request for Project Renewal, was submitted.
2. The basic photographic coverage of the BEDOX installation continues, producing about 50-60 photographs of those officials on whom we still need photo coverage, and visitors.
3. No luck has been experienced in getting documentary photography, the reason being simply that the window through which photos must be taken has not been open at such times as there were documents on the desk.
4. Case officer meetings with LIMOPE/1 continue on a normal once a week basis. At these meetings, held in an operational car, after a street pickup, the case officer picks up the weekly "take" and gives LIMOPE/1 any necessary instructions.
5. LIMOPE/2 continues to perform the basic functions of the Project. He

is handicapped in providing service in radio dispatching of the surveillance team because of partial deafness. The Station is attempting to get expert medical opinion on this problem before deciding what, if anything, can be done about this problem.

6. Both LIMOPE/1 and LIMOPE/2 seem to be well pleased with their work, and the money that comes from it.

7. No known security problems have come to the Station's attention during the reporting period.

8. On 13 August 1963 the Station was informed by Phillip K. TESSAROLO that he had, at our bidding, renewed the lease on the LITABBY basehouse for the one year period, 27 June 1963 - 26 June 1964, in the amount of \$19,000.00 MN. This reflected a saving of \$6,500.00 MN compared to last year's rent.

Plans

9. No change in present operating procedures is planned at the present time. LITABBY is set up to accomplish a limited, but useful operational support function. The photo coverage derived from the basehouse and the ability to monitor the comings and goings of BEDOX officials and visitors is believed to warrant the small expenditure of time and effort.
