MEMORANDUM No. 9

SUBJECT: Garrison and the Kennedy Assessination

I. SUMMARY

This memorandum provides information about twenty persons who have not been listed previously in this series, who are involved in the Gerrison case, and who have or have claimed to have a connection with the Central Intelligence Agency. One. William Clarens WOOD, is a former staff employee.

II. PERSONNEL

- 1. Thomas Edward BECKHAM (aka Mara EVANS) -
- a. GARRISON subpossed BECKHAM 30 December 1767 and an Omaha, Nebraska, judge ordered him to return to Louisiana 30 January 1968. BECKHAM mays he helped Sergio ARCACHA Smith raise funds for Cuban revolutionary forces in New Orleans in 1962. BECKHAM is an entertainer-syangelist who uses the stage name of Mark EVANS.
- b. On 3 January 1963 BECKHAM allegedly told David LEWIS of New Orleans that he, BECKHAM, and a Jim LNU "from Omaka" are agents of the CIA.
 - c. RID has no record of BECKHAM.
- 2. Melvin BELLI
 - e. BELLI was a defense attorney for Jack RUBY.
- b. Jim GARRISON was a weekend guest of BELLI when GARRISON visited San Francisco in October 1967.



- c. BELLI was reportedly involved in illicit drug tratfic with Morris ELOWITZ in 1958. ELOWITZ was a suspected contact of Lucky LUCIANO.
- A 3. Fonald Fean BOHNING (201-813769)
 - a. BCHNING is the Latin American Editor of the Miacul Herald. He was granted a PCSA on 21 August 1967 and a CSA on 14 November 1967. He is AMCARBON-3.
 - b. BOHNING reported he was contacted on 28 March 1968 by a Winston SMITH who claimed to be investigating Relandu MASPERRER for Jim GARHISON.

*4. Celonel L. Robert CASTORR

- a. Col. CASTORR allegedly met with Jack RUBY, Robert PERRIN, and others in Dallas in 1962 to plan a Cuban sanuggling operation. CASTORR is also allegedly an associate of General Edwin A. WALKER. Joachim JOESTEN and others have broadly binted that CASTORR is associated with CIA.
- b. There is no record of agency association with CASTORR. An FBI report of 13 March 1769 reported that CASTORR had lunch with Viktor Ivanovich MIRONOV (201-731745), a RGB officer at the Soviet Erabassy in Washington.
- 5. Lloyd J. COBB /
- a. As President of the New Orleans Trade Center, COBB was, according to Plot or Pelitics, the "boss" of Clay SHAW.
- 5. COBB was granted a CSC on 3 October 1953 for use on a private attorneys' panel for the OGC. COBB was granted a PSA on 19 June 1967 to permit contact and assessment in connection with his use on a cleared attorneys' panel for the OGC.
- xa. Michael Charles CONLEY
 - a. Michael Charles CONLEY is an apparent US Government apparer of Robert Kenneth BROWN.
 - 6. A Trr. Michael C. CONLEY applied for Agency employment in 1984. Identity with a, above, has not been established.

- 7. Allen W. DULLES
- a. GARRISON subposessed Mr. DULLES on 16 February 1968 as a material witness.
- b. On 7 March 1968 Judge Matthew BRANIFF issued a second subposes for Mr. DULLES.
- c. On 22 May 1968 GARRISON's office accused the Justice Department of refusing to cooperate in the supposting of Mr. DULLES as a witness.
- 8. Wieslaw GORNICKI (201-198323)
- a. GORNICKI is a Polish journalist who was the author of a long article on the GARRISON investigation in "Polityka" No. 1 (366). Year XII Warsaw, 6 January 1968.
- a. GORNICKI was the subject of an unsuccessful recruitment attempt in 1965 while he was a correspondent at the UN.
- 9. Marchall Wilson HOUTS (201-633160)
- a. HOUTS, a former FBI agent, is the author of an article in Medical Economics 4 March 1968 which criticized the autopay of Precident Kennedy.
- War II and was involved in the misapprepriation of government property. HOUTS unsuccessfully applied for Agency employment in 1952.
- 10. Guy Persac JOHNSON (201-207873) /
- a. JOHNSON was an early defense counsel for Ciay SHAW.
- b. A POA was requested 14 May 1954 for JOHNSON to be used on Guain as a contract agent for OUKODIAK (training base on Salvan). The request for the POA was later cancelled.
- 11. William R. KLEIN
 - a. According to Plot or Politics KLEIN was an

incorporator of Friends of Democratic Cuba, along with Guy BANISTER, William DALZELL, and Grady C. DURHAM. KLEIN denied contact with DURHAM. BANISTER, and Friends of Democratic Cuba. He admitted association with DALZELL to set up the Free Voice of Latin America. KELIN seems to be a personal friend of Jim GARRISON.

- b. KLEIN applied for agency employment in 1965 but accepted a job with the US Navy General Counsel's Office.
- 12. Robert Evensen LEE
- CARRISON from 1 January 1967 to 1 January 1968.
 - b. LEE applied for agency employment on 5 January 1969.
- 13. William Richard MARTIN (201-298516)
- a. MARTIN was an Assistant District Attorney for Jim GARRISON until December 1967.
- b. MARTIN was a DCb contact and source in 1964 and 1965 when he was Director of International Relations and World Trade of International House in New Orleans.
- × 14. Relman MORIN (201-109129)
- a. MORIN is the author of Assassination, a pro-Warren Commission book.
- b. MORIN provided information to OSS on his interament in Indo China during the early part of World War II.
- c. MORIN was considered for the job of President of the Committee for a Free Asia in 1951 and the job of President of DTFILLAR (Asia Foundation) in 1953.
- 15. Pr. Alton OCHSNER (201-834497)
- a. An FBI confidential informant reported on 24 April 1953 that Jim GARRISON believes Dr. OCHSNER was a principal involved in the conspiracy to assassinate President Rennedy.



Former Head of the American Cancer Society

- b. Dr. OCHSWER is Director of the Ochsner Foundation, head of the Ochsner Clinic, and President of the Information Council of America. He is a world-famous surgeon.
- c. Dr. OCHSNER was of contact interest in October 1967 and November 1948. He has been a cleared source since 13 May 1955. The last official contact with Dr. OCHSNER personally occurred on 8 January 1962 and with the Ochoner Clinic on 8 November 1963.

16. Robert PERRIN

- a. Robert FERRIN allegedly met with Jack RUDY.

 Cel. L. Robert CASTORE, and others in Dallas in 1962

 to plan a Cuban synugiling operation. FERRIN has been accused
 of being a CIA gun-runner in Spain and in Cuba.
- b. A Lt. (jg) Robert Polloch FERRIN filed a personal history statement with OSS in January 1944. There is no indication he over cerved with OSS or was later connected with the Agency.

17. Benjamin SONNENBERG

- Rush To Judgement: "I am deeply indebted to Bonjacuin EONNENBERG, Jr. whose numerous and invaluable suggestions have found their way into this volume."
- b. Benjamin SONNENBERG was granted a CEA on 29 June 1959 for use under Project CRENCHANT. The CSA was revalidated for continued use on 25 July 1965.
- c. An April 1959 Duma and Bradstreet report listed SONNENBERG as a director of the publishing firm of Henry Holt and Company. Inc., 233 Madison Ave., New York City.

 Rush To Judgement was published by Holt, Rinchart and Wilson Inc., 303 Madison Ave., establish the same company.
- d. An October 1954 FEI report said that in 1938 Alfred K. STEEN earmarked \$3000 in a bank account to guarantee a bank loan made to SONNENSERG.

- e. There is no indication that SONNENBERG ever used the term "junior" and it is not known yet if he has a son of that name.
- 18. Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Bloom STERN (Me to 201-178541)
- e. Jack ROGERS, the committee counsel for the joint legislative Committee on Un-American Activities for the State of Louisiana, reported to the DCS on 1 June 1967, that GARRISON had been receiving contributions and monetary apport from Mrs. Edgar B. STERN.
- b. Mrs. Edgar B. STERN is the former Edith ROSENWALD and the former eleter-in-law of Alfred K. STERN.
- c. Clay SHAW attended a party given by "an old friend". Edith STERN, apparently in October 1997.
- d. Edgar B. STERN was granted a covert clearance to January 1963 for use as a donor to Project LPCOIN. This clearance was cancelled in September 1956.
- e. Philip Maurice STERN, son of the above mentioned couple, was granted a listson clearance in March 1961 when he was the Legaty Assistant Secretary of State for Public Affairs. Philip ETERN was also named as one of a "board of advisors" to Mubert HUMPHREY in 1961.

MIN. Monroe SULLIVAN

- a. SULLIVAN claimed to be with Clay SHAW in Sea Francisco all day 22 November 1963.
- b. SULLIVAN was granted a CSA on 10 December 1962 to permit utilization under Project QKENCHANT.
- 20. William Clarens WOOD (201-534272)
- a. A Bill WOOD, using the name Bill BOXLEY, is investigating GIA and its operations for Jim GARRISON.
- b. Bill WOOD is believed to be identical with William Clarens WOOD, a former staff employee of this Agency.



was approved for CSS duty in December 1944, but was not utilized. On 13 December 1950 WOOD was granted a CSC for utilization as a Staff Agent with Project TFFOCUS. He suffered a nervous breakdown in March 1952. He was assigned to CTR as an instructor (GS-11) in May 1952. He resigned 27 January 1953, after his resignation had been requested, because of alcoholism. While under the influence of sodium pentorhol during a medical operation in July 1953 WOOD made statements showing extreme antagonism toward the Agency. The FBI reported in April 1967 that WOOD had effored assistance to the Nationalist Chinese Intelligence Service. DCS requested clearance to use WOOD in February 1967 but dropped the request after the FBI reported that he was drinking heavily again.
