39. | Coverage <sup>24 Oct</sup> shows 2 frames of unid. individual on 1 Oct in front of 2 entering Gov compound via gate. Coverage on 15 Oct shows 2 of same individual. (P8593-VH.III)

X 40. Hqs. in. Mex. re Warren group visit (13026): "... all needed assistance with minimum possible disclosure of assets and techniques ..." (see VH.III)

41. In June 64 Major Pitaro conducted extensive investigation and follow up of a lead provided by one Glaris Rojas Villanueva in Guadalajara and Cozumel, including extensive planning of a polygraphing (that proved not to be necessary). Rojas another self promoted informant or alleged operation of Oswald in contact with Cubans in Cozumel. Story was unverified & possibly rebutted by other witnesses

City hours from 1700 to 2200 awaiting an inst passenger who arrived Mex. airport in private twin motor aircraft at 2400 transferred directly without customs or immigration & stayed in pilot's cabin. Compare entry 23 Dec 64 CSC 316/02545-64 which reported entry red by a source since decreased from Cuban source, who was also on the plane and reported on Havana airport.

43. What are the ramifications of LHO. relations with Fair Play for Cuba Committee executed?

(a) Vincent Thurston Lee - went to Cuba via Mexico City 28 Dec 62, returns Mex 21 Jan 1963. Travelled with Eliz. Catlett de Moran (Betty Moran) E.S.

44. Cuban Govt doc. provided via Swiss, consisted of a Visa Applica. dated 27 Sept 63. which indicated planned date of arrival in Cuba on 30 Sept 63 [i.e. arrival] for "in transit on the way to the Soviet Union" after a stay in Cuba of 2 weeks (and longer if possible). An accompanying notations indicates Lee displayed "docs. in proof of his membership" in CPUSA and F.P.F.C. New Orleans.

45. As of Sept 1964 Sylvia Duran had given up her Cuban Embassy job and had disappeared. Husband stated she was out of Mexico. Husband carrying no abs. Early Oct reports she had been in excursion with students to colonies Mayaguez & Merida.

Elena Carras de Pay - memo of 10 Dec 1965 - relates alleged night of Oswald on Sept 1963 party at home of Ruben Duran, attended by Azcua, and a Cuban American Negro with red hair (see Alvarez story) and others. (P-8533 vol 10) Mrs Pay is cousin of Horacio Duran, Sylvia's husband. The very hotels & latter. Pay assertions made to Legat 17-24 Nov 64 & inquiry failed to substantiate, a Legat memo of 23 Feb 66 indicated: no further action.

✓ 47. Rowton Report 26 May 1967 on meeting with Cuban Committee  
person. LIRING/3 indicates lobby was an old contact of  
Selva & Horacio Duran. Selva Duran a receptionist at  
Cuban Cons. 1513-4 had been placed by Teresa Proenza,  
the press attache. Duran had claimed to LIRING/3 that she  
had gone out with LHO. & had sexual relations with him, had

✓ 48. Report by Am. Cons. Tampico, Brig. J. Ruyfe dated 11 May 1967

group afternoon, evening & all of following day. He did not  
pay this day. Recog. because of several copies of photo. Oswald  
gave seeking assist. of pro-Castro students to help persuade  
Cuban Cons. to grant him a visa. Spoke letters by. No further  
contact after 2nd day. This report forwarded by Ruyfe with  
comments. but source also said he had known Maria  
Teresa Proenza. Source was: Oscar Contreras, <sup>Castigane</sup> reporter for  
El Sol de Tampico at Univ. of Mex. 60-64. Interviewed on 25 June 67.  
He very cautious because of leakage danger. Contreras vague on  
details and fixed on denial if confronted. (We had indep. traces  
on Contreras showing his UNAM rec. bloc contacts in June 1961)  
Story passed to Legat City by memo 5 July 1967. (Following indicated

Item of interest is MOR dated 27 NOV 63 passed on a Dulles FO memo of 25 NOV. 1963 reporting a cover. Reported by SLOJ of Dutch FO with Ricardo SANTOS, 3<sup>rd</sup> Secty of Carbon Emb. at a reception given by the Gov. Embassy 1963 saying re articles against Carbon mentioned by Carbon refugees: "My SLOJ just wait and you will see what we can do. It will happen soon". Asked by SLOJ to be more specific about what would happen soon, Santos merely replied: "just wait just wait."

These data passed to RANKIN by Nelson memo 31/3/64 See XAAZ-22601 of this date.

① What action taken on this date? ② translate intercept from Dutch.

CSCI-3/278 594 30 NOV 63: re WEISMAN <sup>beamed</sup> Ad in Dallas showing News. Traces on W's contacts.

Comment: Was testimony taken from <sup>Louis Richard Thomas</sup> ~~Neyo~~ <sup>61550</sup> ~~governor~~ in Swiss, of FPPC who didn't know anyone in April 1963. Born 13 Aug 1931 at LA. Cited as Louis stated in Swiss O. "one of us" at O. high level committee. Answer: yes - in Paris. APM in Dub 3 see XAAZ-17491

Comment: A.M. MUG/1 info provides Comm Attorney P. Wallace on 15 May 1964 and reviewed in detail with me on 18 June by A.E. Drury - on reminisces (see XAAZ 27166 of 19 June 1964).

CSCI 3/779,135 of 16 Dec 1963: Peter Bergstein's Comments in the Kennedy Assassination. 8 pages + loose to FBI. Cambria's impressionistic comment with incisive suggestions for interview of Marina. States that KGB had three years to assess LHO. and notes that historically most assassins have been unbalanced uneducated types.

NB: Hq. Cont 90466 of 20 Dec. indicates "our present plan in passing inf. to Cuban Commission is to eliminate mentions of telephone taps, in order to protect your continuing ops. Will rely instead on statements of Suber and contents of Soviet consular file."

UF-6 - 428, 19 Dec 1963. (Vol 10). Info obtained from brother of Belgium Terror by a source whose id. not yet est. Costas highly critical of the Rca. notes of 26 Nov 1963 re arrest of Cuban consulate employees. Notes too strong & would not contribute to harmonious Cuban-Mexico relations. Comment: this is arguable hearing. The tone & content of notes was certainly consistent with tone & content of Fidel Castro's TV speech on 23rd Nov & his follow up broadcast.

CSCI 3/779, 297 of 27 Dec 1963: Re report passed to FBI by field  
at Miami on 7 Dec 1963 alleging assass. of Kennedy arranged  
in Cuba by Cuban govt & Chicanos, naming Juan Saavedra,  
Ramon B. Cortes, Fernandez Fetto and Robert Watts. No  
Hqs. dossier has been being checked. Source was W. Eric  
dig. who had mixed track record on prev. reporting. Query  
on 7 Dec. but report is still seriously in doubt. Raul  
SAAVEDRA supposedly made the statements. He supposedly  
knew a high cuban govt official, but no identity forthcoming.  
S's comment allegedly received by a workman, who told  
an unid indiv. who told our source. Inf. first-  
hand at least. Source will not identify his source. He  
source has in past produced several sens. reports that had  
proven untrue - believed not delib. but because he is unable  
to eval. info properly.
