

We have no major comments on the draft decision memorandum. I would suggest one relatively minor change, however. On page 2, paragraph b, regarding the placement of the Historical Review Group, I would like to see the wording be a bit more open-ended. When we fully establish a CIO and its subordinate organizations, it might make sense to place the HRG in that structure. Accordingly, I would insert in the first sentence of paragraph b after the word intelligence, "for the time being." ✓
