PHILADELPHIA AND NEWARK PHYSICAL SURVEILLANCE JUNE 19 CONFIRMED BRUNO ATTEMPTED TO HIDE COLOGERIO SINATRA, VENTNOR, NJ.

PH 614-C-TE REPORTED SINATRA TRANSPORTED PHILADELPHIA TO TRENTON, NJ, BETWEEN 10 AND 11 PM, JUNE 18 BY PETER MAGGIO, PROBABLY TO RESIDENCE CHARLES COSTELLO FOR MOVEMENT TO "SHORE" JUNE 20. BRUNO "TO CALL" COSTELLO EVENING JUNE 19 AND IS GOING "OUT OF TOWN" JUNE 20 FOR A DAY.

NEWARK ATTEMPT VERIFY [SINATRA'S PRESENCE COSTELLO'S] AND PREPARE TO ASSIST POSSIBLE PHYSICAL SURVEILLANCE TRENTON, VENTNOR, NOON JUNE 20.
