Synopsis: Subject's birth, education, and background information set forth. Informants advised subject and wife left United States in 1961 for travel to Cuba. Correspondence received in United States from subject and wife in Cuba. JONES filed application for renewal of passport in 1961 and passport contained restriction that it was not valid for travel to Cuba. Subject was in Moscow, Russia, with group from Cuba in September, 1963, according to three United States citizens who talked with him in Moscow. JONES indicated he was not a member of the CP but sympathized with aims and goals of Communist movement. JONES indicated he was in agreement with CASTRO's policies.

A review of the subject's file reveals he has not been interviewed during this investigation.

AN FD 122 is being submitted as instructed in Bureau letter 2/17/64, recommending subject be included in the SI. As pointed out in Bureau letter, no evidence has been developed that subject was a member of any revolutionary group or a leader or organizer of a Pro-CASTRO organization prior to his departure from the United States. However, his actions and statements coupled with his presence in Cuba qualify him for inclusion in the SI.
