1. AS OF 3 JUNE 65, CUBAN MILITIA TROOPS WERE PURSUING MEN WHOM THEY PRESUMED HAD LANDED AT THREE LOCATIONS (NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED) ON THE NORTHERN COAST OF CUBA. (FIELD COMMENT: SOURCE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED THAT MILITIA, POLICE AND ARMY TROOPS WERE PURSUING NUMEROUS INSURGENTS IN THE MOUNTAINS NEAR CONSOLACION DEL NORTE, PINAR DEL RIO PROVINCE/ THE TROOPS COMMENTED THAT THEY HAD FOUND EMPTY PARACHUTES. S.)
