THIS DATE A REPRESENTATIVE OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, POLICE DEPARTMENT ADVISED THEY HAD RECEIVED A LETTER FROM THE EDITOR OF "EL CLARIN", A WEEKLY SPANISH LANGUAGE NEWSPAPER PUBLISHED AT ELIZABETH, NEW JERSEY TO THE EFFECT THAT ON MAY TWENTY NEXT AT SIX PM MOTORCADES WILL LEAVE FROM ELIZABETH, PERTH AMBOY, PATERSON, NEWARK, JERSEY CITY AND UNION CITY ALL IN NEW JERSEY, DESTINED TO CENTRAL PARK, NEW YORK CITY. THEY WILL MEET IN FRONT OF JOSE MARTI STATUE AND END WITH SINGING OF PATRIOTIC HYMNS. THE PURPOSE OF THE DEMONSTRATION IS TO SUPPORT PRESIDENT JOHNSON'S POLICIES IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, VIETNAM, AND IN COMMEMORATION OF CUBAN INDEPENDENCE DAY.

Night Supervisor, New York, Arthur Nehrbass, instructed to furnish this additional information to New York City Police Department.

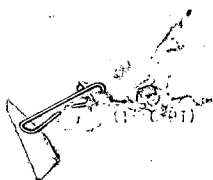
