TODDO MARINO, true name SALVATORE GAETANO MAIORANO, FBI# 1644357, who was mentioned by Lt. JACOBS, is an influential member of the GENOVESE "family" who hangs out at 20th Street and 5th Avenue, Brooklyn, NY.

RUDY (LNU) and DOM PRADO are not sufficiently identified at this time.

Also mentioned in referenced airtels is the name JACK LEVINIA (PH), who is apparently a partner with GAETANO "CORKY" VASTOLA in an illegal alcohol operation. LEVINIA is probably identical with JOHN LIVIGNO, NYCPD B# 164755, age 61, ATTD# 4088. LIVIGNO is also known as JACK LIVIGNY and JACK LEVINE. LIVIGNO's last known residence was 8701 Shore Road, Brooklyn, NY.

LIVIGNO was described in 1960 by ATTD agents as the top moonshiner on the East Coast. He was arrested in 1954 for running a 1000 gallon still on the Brooklyn waterfront and pleaded guilty on 2/19/60, EDNY, Brooklyn, and sentenced along with his brother, MORRIS LIVIGNO, to 2 years imprisonment. Another moonshiner sentenced with LIVIGNO was GIOACHINO "LAUNDRY JACK" MENTESANO.

It should be noted that NY 3586-C-TE has associated with LIVIGNO in the past and will be discreetly contacted concerning the location of LIVIGNO's present operation.
