(prior) investigation." He was informed that the RCMP considered the prior investigation to be adequate in every degree and Congressman EDGAR made repeated efforts to explain away the remark.

RCMP agreed to assist the HSCA by making available any of its members for interview; attempting to locate persons previously interviewed by RCMP and determine if the person was agreeable to interview by HSCA investigators, in the presence of RCMP; and doing name checks on any new names surfaced in the HSCA investigation. RCMP did not agree to allowing HSCA to review its files, to conduct any new investigation for the HSCA or to allow the committee to conduct any investigation in Canada. Congressman EDGAR was told that any requests for investigation in Canada must be presented to the RCMP through the FBI or through diplomatic channels.



As to the Invader situation, it is understood that the FBI will locate and sanitize the informant files of all informants within the Invaders during 1968 and provide the Committee with access to these files. The sanitizing process will be undertaken only to the extent necessary to protect the identity of the informants. The FBI will also provide the Committee, for interview purposes, with the control agent or agents for these Invader informants. This Committee, however, reserves the right to request production of the identity of all Invader informants during 1968 should the sanitized files and agent interviews—be inconclusive on the issues to be resolved by the Committee.

As to the informants who have provided information relative to the Klan relationship with Arthur Hanes, Sr., during the course of Hanes' representation of James Earl Ray, it is understood that the FBI will contact the informants listed in the serials listed below to determine if an interview with this Committee can be arranged:

DETAILS:

On March 23, 1978, Mr. Robert Keuch, Deputy\_Assistant Attorney General, Criminal Division, who was the Special Counsel to the Attorney General for matters relating to captioned Committee, advised SA Danny O. Coulson of the Legal Counsel Division that the staff for captioned Committee had asked for access and delivery of documents prepared by the Department of Justice in its inquiry into the FBI's investigation of the

assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King. Mr. Keuch further advised that the documents requested by the Committee are... heavily excised due to sensitive informant information, and these excisions have raised questions on the part of the Committee which can only be resolved by a briefing for

Louis Stokes, Chairman, Samuel L. Devine, Ranking Minority, and G. Robert Blakey, Chief Counsel to the Committee. Mr. Keuch has indicated he will discuss this matter with the Attorney General and will recommend that these individuals be briefed on the "Solo" operation the desires to obtain

the FBI's views for the briefing concerning these specific individuals. ( ) 137

This matter has been discussed with representatives of the Intelligence Division who express no objections. to briefings regarding this matter, as long as it is restricted to those three individuals. (U)
