BENITO RESHAK (ph). WARNER stated that he recalled this note. VICIOSO then asked if WARNER knew if any special consideration was being given to this matter. WARNER stated that the note has been sent to the U. S. Bureau of Internal Revenue, for preparation of a reply, but as yet they have not received any material from IRS to draft the reply. In reply to VICIOSO's question, WARNER stated that he didn't think it would be very long before a reply is received. VICIOSO stated that AMB. MANUEL DE MOYA has an interest in this matter, and asked VICIOSO to call WARNER concerning it, and VICIOSO asked if WARNER knew what the feeling was concerning. 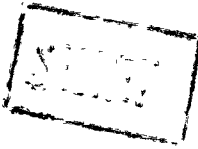
