Dear Mr. Bates:

This is a follow-up to my letter to you dated September 14. In that letter, I endeavored to provide directly, or through reference to other individuals, articles, and reports, all of the information in my possession on the death of White House Deputy Counsel Vincent Foster. At this time I would like to supplement that letter.

I would like to call to your attention a report prepared by two private investigators, Vincent Scalice and Fred Santucci, on behalf of the Western Journalism Center. This report includes, inter alia, that the gun had "likely been staged" or placed in Foster's hand after death. I am enclosing a copy of that report for your use.

Second, I want to specifically bring to your attention the controversy about whether all the photographs taken in connection to this matter have been produced, and recommend that this issue be carefully reviewed.

Further, I am enclosing another set of articles which I believe originate from the Internet, and particularly point out that individuals identified as forensics experts are quoted as disputing the official findings. I recommend those people be interviewed.

Finally, I respectfully reiterate that because of the high profile of this case, I and many of my House colleagues strongly desire to see the Office of Special Counsel and Grand Jury conduct the broadest possible investigation, with all theories being given consideration.

Again, thank you for allowing me to provide this information and suggestions. Please be assured of any cooperation I can provide to your office.
