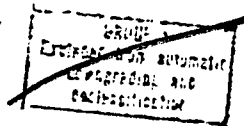
2. We are forwarding, for your information, a copy of the composite, along with the photographs and list of stations received from your office.

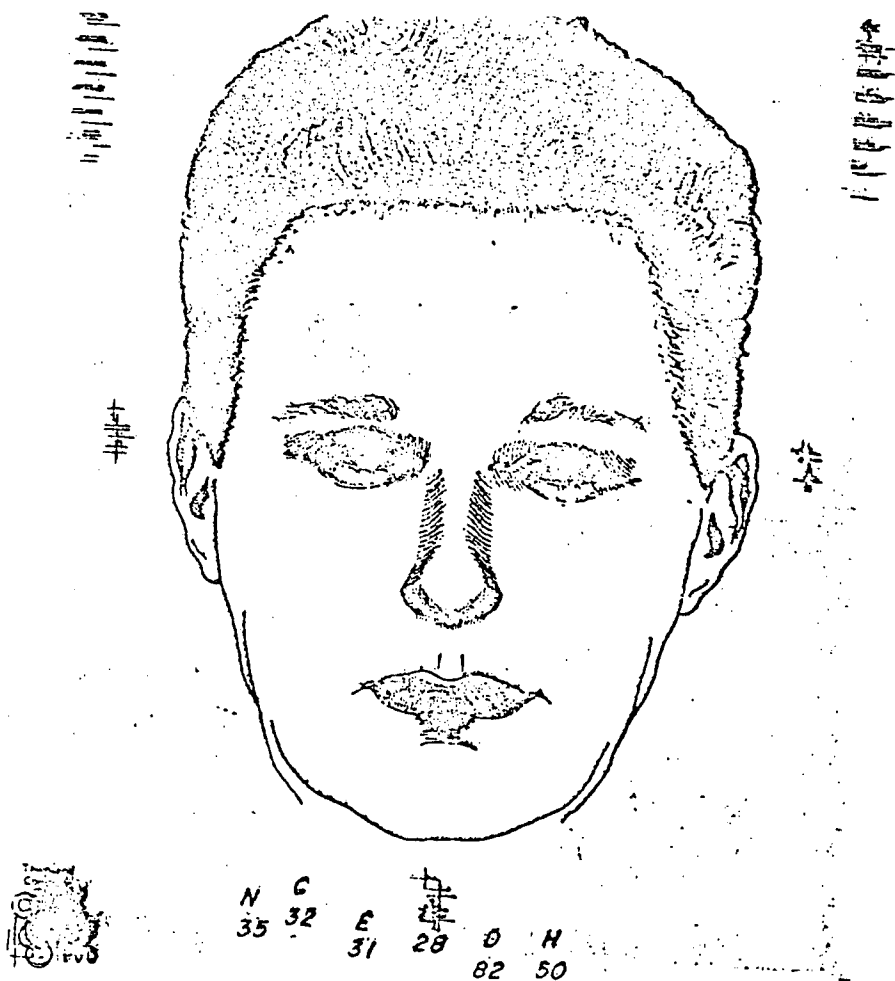

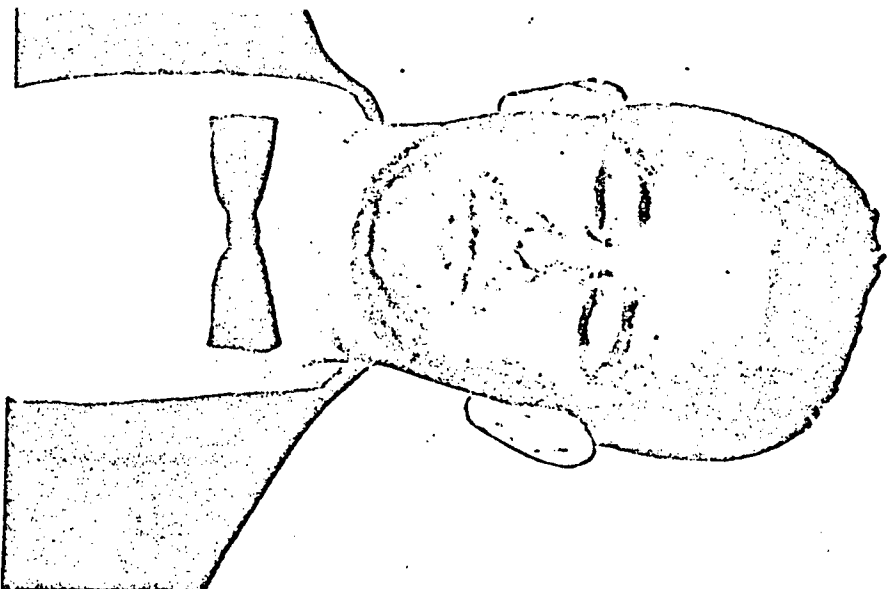

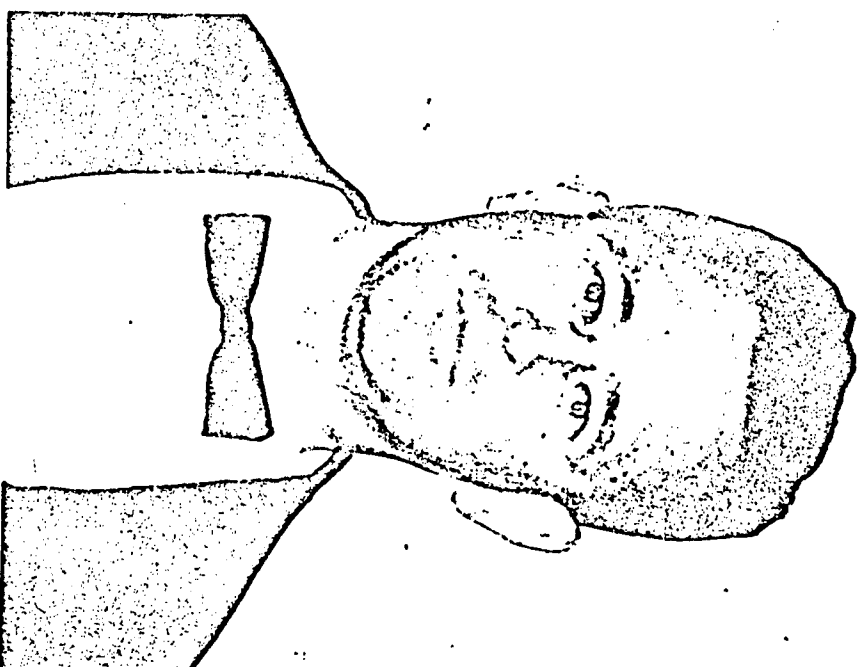
