Enclosed for Little Rock are two copies of Denver teletype to Director and Memphis dated 5/24/68, which summarizes interview with Mrs. HOMER LANE BIGELOW. Denver, Colorado.

ROBERT EDWARD BYRNE located and interviewed 5/28/68. Categorically denies any involvement in or knowledge of MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassination. He claims Mrs. HOMER LANE BIGELOW is mentally a "very sick person," who was merely trying to keep him from marrying GENEVIEVE BYRNE He stated that at least most of the events described by Mrs. BIGELOW did take place, such as their trip to Acapulco, Mexico, his trip to Lubbock, Texas, and their visit with JAMES HEYER but she added to what took place when she claimed he indicated he was involved in a conspiracy to kill KING.

He said the trip to Acapulco was for pleasure only, but, naturally, he and HAL HALE discussed oil deals since they are associates in several oil ventures. He recalled a conversation with Mrs. BIGELOW in Acapulco wherein he mentioned in vague terms an oil deal in Kansas he was working on with HALE, but no connection with a criminal syndicate was even implied. He stated that he avoided talking business with her because she fancied herself as an investor and a business woman, which she was not, and he did not want her becoming involved in any of his dealings. He recalled that she again brought up the subject of marriage during this conversation and that if he did not marry her, her daughter, JENNIFER, would be hurt. He said he told her that he did not want to hurt JENNIFER, but that he was not going to marry her.



Rememo of SA THOMAS H. WISEMAN, 5/23/68, concerning information furnished on that date by Mrs. HOMER LANE BIGALOW, 4331 East Mexico, Denver, Colorado.

On 5/23/68, CSDN 239-C was contacted for the purpose of identifying BOB BYRNE, and HAL HALE and to determine the extent of their association with each other and with Denver attorney JAMES HEYER, who is probably identical with JAMES HYER mentioned in referenced memorandum.

The source related that HAL HALE, for a priod of eight or ten years, operated as an oil drilling contractor in the Denver area, closely associated with JERRY RYAN, former operator of the New Drilling Company, now defunct. He stated that RYAN now operates an oil drilling and exploration company in the Denver Club Building, known as Jerry Ryan and Company.

Informant stated that after New Drilling went out of business HAL HALE went to the State of Ohio where he was interested in drilling operations. This was about 2½ years ago and the informant has not been in touch with him since that time.






