On 5/8/68, copies of these two photographs, as well as a copy of the Wanted Flyer, were sent to all of the newspapers and television stations in the El Paso Division.

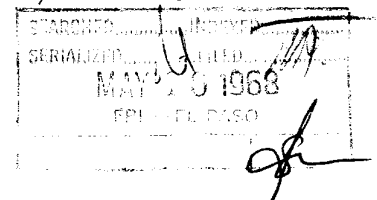
