HENRY R. QUINN, 1211 Westmoreland Avenue, Montgomery, Alabama, advised that he and his cousin JOE LACEY, JR., who resides at the same address, are in the interior decorator business together. QUINN advised that he and LACEY traveled to New Orleans, Louisiana, in December of 1967, in a white Chevrolet station wagon, for the purpose of purchasing antiques in the French Quarter in New Orleans for a client of theirs, Mrs. ELIZABETH B. PANWELL. QUINN stated that while in New Orleans, they stayed at the Provencial Motel on Chartres Street. QUINN stated that they customarily take room 126 while staying in New Orleans at the Provencial Motel because of its convenient location to their automobile which is customarily parked in front of the door of Room 126.

QUINN stated that he has lived in Montgomery, Alabama, for the past fifteen years and has been employed there with his cousin, JOE LACEY, JR., as a free lance interior decorator. He stated that he was born in Shelby County, North Carolina, on [redacted]

He stated that while in New Orleans he did not spend much time at the motel but was busy shopping for antiques and that he did not notice anything suspicious while at the motel.
