The following investigation was conducted by SA
ROBERT S. KENNEMUR:

On May 7, 1968, RANDOLPH D. JONES, Pure Oil Station, Americus, Georgia, reviewed the credit card purchase slips which were obtained from the Chicago Office regarding purchases at his station on April 15, 16, 17, and 18, 1968. Mr. JONES advised that all of the purchases which were recorded in his name could be eliminated by him as persons who are known to him with the exception of a purchase made by GEORGE B. FRANKS, Pure Oil Credit Card Number [REDACTED]. Mr. JONES observed that this credit card was to expire in July of 1968, and he believed that this was possibly the person to whom he had sold the gas who resembled the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY.

The Pure Oil Company, Retail Department, Palatine, Illinois, had furnished the address of Mr. FRANKS as 707 Virginia Avenue, Glennville, Georgia.

On 5/16/68 LENIE RAYMOND DOWDA, 108 Orchard Road, Smyrna, Ga., was re-interviewed and advised that he and his wife drove their 1966 Volkswagen to California to spend the Thanksgiving holiday 1967 with his wife's uncle, ROBERT GRAHAM, Palos Verdes, Calif.

DOWDA advised he and his wife arrived at Palos Verdes the day before Thanksgiving 1967, spent Thanksgiving Day with the GRAHAM residence and left about 9 or 10 a.m. the following morning with \$45 or \$50 to go to Santa Rosa, Calif., to see if they could locate DON RISSERS. DOWDA advised they left Palos Verdes and drove directly to Monterey, Calif. DOWDA advised they took the coast highway all the way to Monterey and arrived around midnight on the day following Thanksgiving. DOWDA stated on the way to Monterey they stopped on the beach to have a picnic for a couple of hours. He stated other than that they did not stop except for routine purposes until they arrived at Monterey. DOWDA advised they stayed at Monterey for only a couple of hours to rest and never did get a motel or any other kind of accommodations. He stated while there, in evaluating their finances, they realized they did not have sufficient funds to go on to Santa Rosa and, therefore, decided to return to Palos Verdes. DOWDA advised while they were in Monterey he did not lose his wallet nor any money or anything else that he could recall. He stated the only money that he did lose during the

whole trip to California was \$200 at the Grand Canyon, the money apparently falling out of his pocket. DOWDA advised that they arrived back at Palos Verdes the following day and later borrowed some \$75 from MR. GRANAM in order to get back to Georgia. DOWDA advised he did lose his wallet around 12/67 or 1/68 while visiting his father in Deland, Fla. He advised he could provide no additional details re this loss of his wallet.

DOWDA stated no other events transpired during the time he and his wife traveled to Monterey and they left the GRANAM residence the day after they returned from the Monterey trip.

Mr. MARK CODDINGHAM, DAL Audit Office, on 5/6/68, advised ticket used by Passenger RAY reflects he is JIMMIE RAY, traveling in Army Uniform on military half fare and that he has ASN 671-41-671.

Delta Flight #345- 4/11/68 to Columbia, S. C.

Manifest reflects passenger by name of RAY or ROY was passenger this flight, his name being added to manifest at gate.

Mr. CODDINGHAM (supra) advised ticket used for flight #345 was issued at military fare to one 1st Lt. WILLIAM D. RAY, ASN FV3176188, who was traveling in uniform from Tinker AFB, Okla. while on leave from 4/5-18/68.

Mr. Tom DeWALT (supra) on May 16, 1968, caused a check to be made of reservation records and advised that above passenger was a Miss RAY travelling with one Mr. FOWLER. This travel originated in Lynchburg, Va., on a Piedmont Air Line booking.

It is obvious this could not be subject.

Delta Flight #107 - 4/7/68 to New Orleans, La.

Manifest reflects that reservations were had for RAY as 1st class passenger and also for Tourist passenger.

Mr. DEWALT, passenger Reservations Supervisor Delta Air Lines advised their reservation records reflect that this was faulty booking as there was only one Passenger on this flight having name of RAY. Records reflect that passenger RAY flew tourist on 4/7/68 from Philadelphia to Atlanta and on to New Orleans, La. On 4/10/68 this passenger flew from New Orleans, La back to Philadelphia, his point of origin, via Delta Flights #902 to Atlanta and Flight #342 to Philadelphia.

Telephonic contact with Francis Travel Bureau reflects that H.G. Ray is an official with Oscar Mayer Packing Co. and usually books his travels thru this agency.

Manifest reflects that G.R. & Mrs. BLALOCK along with JORGENSEN were Atlanta boarding passengers this flight.

Mr. DEWALT advised that according to their reservation data, JORGENSEN is Mr. MATT L. JORGENSEN, 3162 Lenox Road and Mr. & Mrs. G. R. BLALOCK left contact of 634-0373. By pretext phone calls it was determined that MATT L. JORGENSEN is Secretary Abrem-Robeson Co. and that he is presently out of the country. Inquiry in the neighborhood of 2397 Williams Lane Decatur, Ga. reflects that Mr. & Mrs. George R. Blalock have resided at this address in University Apartments for over two years and that they are at the present time outside of the country.

Re Los Angeles airtel to the Bureau 5/14/68, setting forth a letter written by Mrs. ALMENA LOMAX, of Los Angeles, California, who published the Tuskegee Tribune in Tuskegee, Alabama, 1964 and 1965. She suggested the possibility that some of the people who subscribed to the Tuskegee Tribune during that time might have been implicated in the murder of Dr. KING.

Mobile files reflect a LHM submitted to the Bureau 11/12/64, reflecting that LOMAX moved to Tuskegee, Alabama, in late 1964, and published the Tuskegee Tribune. It was set forth that Dr. JULIAN GILES, Director of the VA Hospital, Tuskegee, regarded her as a "mentally sick" person.

In this same file Los Angeles LHM dated 1/18/65, LA file 100-51442, set forth that CS LA 3184-S advised on 1/14/65, that LOMAX was considered untrustworthy by most all the various Negro organizations and groups in the Los Angeles area, and none of them would give her financial backing. This source said that many people acquainted with her questioned her mental capacity.

In addition, the authors of want ads appearing in the metropolitan Atlanta newspaper re used cars for sale during the period 3/24-4/5/68, were contacted, all look-alike complaints resolved through interview, appropriate agency checks and neighborhood investigation where warranted.

The foregoing efforts proved negative and results are not being set forth in this report. Results of each inquiry appear in Atlanta file in appropriate form.

Copies of this report for the United States Attorneys at Birmingham and Memphis are included with copies for those offices, but not marked as such. Dissemination to be held in abeyance pending Bureau instructions.

With reference to interviews of RAYMOND LOUIS CURTIS, this individual stated he would not testify to the information he furnished because he feared for his life. It is noted that CURTIS furnished the same information to the national news media.
