


BETTY NAILS, Anniston Credit Bureau, Anniston, Alabama, advised that the files of her Bureau failed to reveal any information concerning a Hand Bonding Company. She was also unable to locate any information on either a FRED MARCH or a ROBERT ERIC GALT (GAULT).

Detective JOHN DOUGLAS, Anniston Police Department, Anniston, Alabama, advised that he had lived in the Anniston Area for in excess of twenty years and he has never known of a Hand Bonding Company, or of a FRED MARCH who might be associated with any of the local Bonding companies. DOUGLAS, also searched the files of his department and advised that he was unable to locate any information regarding ROBERT ERIC GALT (GAULT) or FRED MARCH.

Sheriff ROY SNEAD, Calhoun County Sheriff's Office, Anniston, Alabama, who has lived in the Anniston, Calhoun Cunty area all his life, advised that the Hand Bonding Company, FRED MARCH, and ROBERT ERIC GALT (GAULT), were totally unfamiliar to him.

The following investigation was conducted by SA PATRICK J. MOYNIHAN on April 7 and 8, 1968. SA JOHN H. KRESEK assisted in investigation on April 8, 1968.

MARSHALL LONG identified himself as the Dispatcher for this system in Birmingham, regularly present at the terminal between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. His phone is 251-5615. He resides at 2320 Hawksbury Lane (Bluff Park), Birmingham, Alabama (822-4285).

Mr. LONG observed the first artist's conception and the second artist's conception on April 7 and April 8, 1968, respectively, and advised that he did not recognize this individual and had seen no one like him at any time in the recent past in the bus terminal or using the facilities.

LONG identified the three regular bus drivers and the relief driver who on a regular basis over the past three or four months have handled the three round trips a day between Birmingham, Alabama, and Memphis, Tennessee. These Birmingham drivers take the Memphis bus from Birmingham to Iuka, Mississippi, where they turn the bus over to a driver operating out of Memphis. On the same day, they pick up the bus coming back from Memphis at Iuka, Mississippi, and drive it back to Birmingham, Alabama. The trip from Birmingham to Memphis is 260 miles and is considered a six-hour trip.

On April 7, 1968, the following drivers were interviewed and the artist's conception was exhibited, but they were unable to identify any passenger in the recent past as similar to or identical with the artist's conception.



It was noted that the color photograph of SALEH greatly resembled the FBI sketch, with the exception that SALEH appeared to have a very dark complexion.



At 9:50 a.m., 4/16/68, Supervisor BILL MARTINDALE at the Bureau telephonically advised as follows:

We are not showing GALT's photograph. However, the Birmingham Office is to show it to one person only, the person who sold the gun to suspect. Of course, if there is another person at the gun store who participated in the sale of the gun to suspect, GALT's photograph must also be shown to him.

GALT's photograph is to be cut down to the same size of the photographs in the group of six photographs which are to be exhibited to the person or persons at the gun shop. Make sure that Galt's name is cut off the photograph and no photographs are to be identified with Galt's name on the back thereof.

This should be handled immediately and the Bureau advised of the results of the showing of the photograph as soon as possible. It is highly probable that Federal process will be issued today.

The Bureau is most concerned that no publicity be given to the fact that we have GALT's photograph, and this fact is not to be disclosed.
